Campers will stay together during all transitions, and activities will be supervised by high-quality trained staff, including a Camp Director.

FREE SWIM TIME

Campers will get 2 hours of free swim time, 5 days a week. Free swim will be supervised by facility lifeguards as well as camp staff.

The safety of each child is of utmost importance; therefore, Rancho Rinconada is a **“Nut-Free Zone.”** Rancho Rinconada supports environmentally responsible practices and we encourage campers to pack reusable containers whenever possible, however, **glass containers are not allowed.**
